Welcome to the New England Knockout Regional! To make your experience more pleasurable, we have prepared an extensive restaurant guide for establishments in Cromwell and neighboring towns. The guide includes 89 restaurants; menus for 75 may be found in the menu binders at the hospitality table. They are organized by town and, within each town, by street. A master list of restaurants is at the hospitality table, and inside each of the menu books. The list includes addresses and phone numbers. Additionally, the restaurants have been classified by cuisine. Multiple copies of this list by cuisine are available for your use and reference. Numbers after the names (C-5, R-2, W-7, etc.) show the town they are located in (Cromwell, Rocky Hill, Wethersfield, etc.), and their number on the master list and in the menu book. Brief directions are included in the master list, and a large map, with reference numbers, is located at the hospitality table. We plan to have the hospitality table staffed AFTER the morning session and briefly AFTER the afternoon session, to answer questions and provide any assistance or advice you need. OFFICIAL ACBL SLOW PLAY POLICY

If you are a habitually (or even occasionally) slow player, you should be aware that there are new rules governing your conduct at the bridge table. These new, stricter rules *will* be applied at this and future tournaments.

The ACBL Board of Directors approved unanimously a new policy, based on references to slow play regulations in the Laws of Duplicate Bridge. Their motion read,



“When a pair has fallen behind, it is incumbent on them to make up the time lost as quickly as possible, *whether at fault or not*. All players are expected to make a concerted effort to catch up when they have fallen behind, regardless of the reason for their lateness.

“In the absence of compelling evidence to the contrary, the director should presume that a pair finishing a round late by more than two or three minutes on more than one occasion during a session is responsible for the lateness. There is a strong expectation that the director will penalize such a pair. The size of the penalty will tend to increase for subsequent instances of slow play and for chronic or egregious slow play. While warnings typically will be given before a penalty is assessed, failure to do so in no way limits the director's authority to issue a penalty.”

Slow play, as opposed to careful or thoughtful play, is discourteous to your opponents -- and to all other competitors as well. Players and pairs who take more than their allotted time will be subject to penalty. And if you do fall behind, *even if through no fault of your own*, you nevertheless have a clear obligation to get caught up as soon as possible.
